

WEB PUBLISH

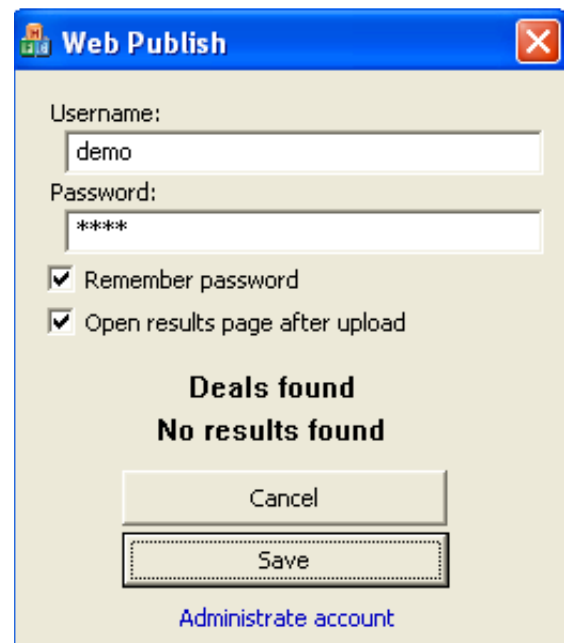
PART 1 - SETUP

1. Apply for a BridgeScorer account. i.e. send an email to support@bridge-scorer.com with the following information:

Club name*
Club address
Contact person
Web page
Email
Preferred user name
*required

2. When you have received username and password:

- Start a new event in BOS.
- Run Web Publish.
- Enter username and password in the dialog that appears (see illustration to the right):
- Save the data



PART 2 - PUBLISH

1. Start BOS

2. Run DupSoft. Either generate deals for your game or [import a deal file](#). Make sure DupSoft has calculated the makable contracts before you close it.

3. Run the scoring program of your choice.

4. Start the Bridge Scorer Control (BSC) from your scoring program.

5. Tick "Web publish automatically" in the [Default] Game Settings dialog
or

5b. Run "Web Publish" from BOS each time you want to publish the results

PART 3 - LINK TO RESULTS PAGES

Follow the instructions below if you want to email (or publish in another way) a direct link to an event:

1. Make sure that you have selected the event that you want to link to.
2. Run Web Publish from BOS (or BridgeScorer Control)
3. Copy the address that your browser shows when the ranking list is displayed.
You can append
&target=1
to the end of the link (without any spaces) if you want the browser to show the results in a new window.


PART 5 - RESULTS BUTTON

The following code snippet will put a Results button on a web page of your choice:



PART 6 - REMOVE [OLD] RESULTS

1. Open BOS with any event.
2. Run Web Publish
3. Click the "[Administrate account](#)" link
4. Enter username and password in the dialog that appears


